Clinical Learning Costs Nursing students will spend a large amount of time off-campus completing their clinical learning experiences and this will involve significant additional costs for students. Clinical can be anywhere in the Greater Wellington Region i.e., Kāpiti Coast, Hutt Valley, Porirua and Wellington; clinical are not arranged based on your home address.
