- Weekly allowance





Beginner	- Students understand Korean alphabet completely and read and write Students understand pronunciation system and pronounce initial-medial-final consonants correctly Students understand Korean language basic structure, tense, conjunction, etc. and the usage of them Students properly use honorific, talk down, indirect discourse Students understand basic daily culture Students freely communicate within studied text contents and can partly solve daily problem.
Intermediate	 Students will have ability to communicate in daily life. Students understand spoken complex sentences and also understand written Korean society and Korean culture related material and broaden their vocabulary while reading those materials. Students will build to communicate longer paragraph including daily conversation, can express their specific opinion, and can write about everyday subject.
Advanced	- Students understand professional area discourses, such as humanities, social, science, art. They will build to express their opinion logically Students will use emotion and sentiment vocabulary and expressions properly when they convey information Students understand Korean culture such as language, education, career, recreational life, science and technology, pop culture, tradition, nature and environment, family and society Students will build ability to attend university level lecture and activities Students will build language ability to understand Korean culture, talk with everyday subject, discuss with social issues, and to undestand Korean history.


